Additional UPS SurePost Charges and Rates

Definition	Charges
Non-Machinable Charge** - An additional charge per package applies to the following: a) Any package with one dimension measuring more than 34 inches and not exceeding 48 inches b) Any package with any two dimensions each measuring more than 17 inches and not exceeding 30 inches c) Any package weighing over 35 lb.	\$4.20 per package
Non-Standard Cube Charge*** - Any package with L x W x H measuring more than 2 cubic feet (3456 cubic inches)	\$15.00 per package
Non-Standard Extra Length Charge*** -Any package with longest side measuring more than 30 inches and not exceeding 48 inches	\$5.00 per package
Non-Machinable Charge*** - An additional charge per package applies to the following: a) Any package with one dimension measuring more than 27 inches and not exceeding 30 inches b) Any package with any two dimensions each measuring more than 17 inches and not exceeding 30 inches c) Any package weighing over 35 lb.	\$4.20 per package
Non-Standard Length Charge*** -Any package with longest side measuring more than 22 inches and not exceeding 27 inches	\$2.00 per package
Delivery Area Surcharge - A surcharge will apply to each UPS SurePost package delivered to certain ZIP Codes within the 48 contiguous states - Refer to the Area Surcharge Listing at ups.com/rates for a listing of applicable ZIP Codes†.	– DAS: \$3.60 – DAS Extended†: \$4.50
Dimensional Weight (DIM) - UPS SurePost packages follow the same dimensional weight formula as UPS Ground - Refer to the UPS Rate and Service Guide at ups.com/rates for information regarding how to calculate dimensional weight.	Billable weight
Demand Surcharge - An additional charge per package will apply to any package shipped during a Demand Period. Applicable Demand Periods and Demand Surcharges are available at ups.com/peaksurcharges and will be updated from time-to-time as Demand Periods and/or Demand Surcharges change. The term Demand Surcharges includes Peak/Demand Surcharges and Peak Surcharges, and the terms are used interchangeably. Refer to ups.com/peaksurcharges prior to shipment for details.
